2024 marks the 60th year since the Community Action Network was established to help American families and communities overcome obstacles to poverty. Over 1,000 agencies across the country are working every day to create opportunities and transform the lives of their neighbors making communities stronger and helping families across the US thrive. Community Action Agencies serve 99% of all American counties with life-changing services to help families achieve financial stability. All agencies are locally controlled and represented by the private, public, and lowincome sectors of the community.



NEICAC's food pantries in Cresco and Waverly were awarded Pantry Development grants through the Northeast Iowa Food Bank (NEIFB) to purchase carts and new vacuums along with other items for pantry operations & signage for our Waverly locations! Access to this grant funding is one of the many benefits of being a NEIFB partner agency.





Weatherization

April was a busy month completing seven homes, State Field Inspections, and Lead Safe Renovator recertifications for staff! Clients reported satisfaction with their homes and the field inspector noted excellent production & good results on tightening the houses.



Early Childhood Programs

Head Start is wrapping up the school year & starting to accept applications for the fall.

Early Head Start is at full enrollment and as our threevear-olds transition out in August, staff will be busy recruiting new families to join!



Housing

Our rental housing units continue to be full but the waiting lists are open for applications-now available in a new fillable form! Currently, 92 individuals are accessing our housing programs. Our Woolen Mill and Washington Court properties are receiving funds to install mini-splits (heat pumps) to provide more efficient heating and cooling!



Transit

In the month of April, our Transit program completed a total of 5,909 trips with a 97% on-time performance rate! We served 38 new customers and 458 passengers total.
