In the month of June, our Transit program completed a total of 3,931 trips, 346 unduplicated passengers, and provided over 1,000 trips for work activities!

## OTHER ASSISTANCE PROVIDED

60 More than 60 households were assisted in maintaining or regaining electric & natural gas services, totaling over \$23,000.

20 20 ECIP applications were approved, totaling \$3,701.91 in assistance.

58 58 Crisis applications were approved, totaling \$21,833.18 in assistance.

Allamakee, Chickasaw, and Fayette counties have received disaster declarations so far this year, opening up the application process for assistance. NEICAC staff are prepared to assist with applications, answer questions, and offer referral and support services as needed.
