FOOD PANTRY DEMAND ON THE RISE



In the first six months of 2024, nearly 68,000 pounds of food was provided to 1,079 individuals through our Bremer, Howard, and Winneshiek County pantries.

321. This is a 32% increase in the pounds of food provided & nearly a 40% increase in the number of unduplicated individuals served through our pantries since the first six months of 2022.



Weatherization

Families participating in the FaDSS program are provided with many different skill building activities.

- Of the 43 families served by FaDSS in July:
- 35 families are involved in Work Preparedness Activities
- 17 families are involved in Parenting Skills Activities - 29 families are involved in Financial Literacy Activities
- 19 families are involved in Life Skills Activities

Transit

In the month of July, our Transit program provided over 2,000 rides to work activities for individuals with disabilities; welcomed 40 new customers; and had an overall on-time performance rate of 96%!

227 F

Customers interacting with NEICAC Family Services specialists received 227 referrals in July 2024.
