Early Childhood Programs

I-Smile clinics were held for EHS families to provide dental, vision, and hearing screenings from the EHS nurse for children ages birth to 3. The program collaborated with the WIC program to provide lead screenings. I-Smile also provided dental screenings for children in our Head Start classrooms and visited children in the transition room.

Head Start classrooms are gearing up for registration for next school year and EHS staff are busy working with families who have 3 year olds transitioning to Head Start and/or other preschool programs in the fall. Staff work hard to help these families plan for the next steps in their children's early childhood education.



FaDSS

During the month of April, the FaDSS program enrolled 2 new families, exited 2 families, served a total of 43 families, and had 15 families on the waiting list. Specialists had 146 significant contacts with family members, 69 collaborative contacts on behalf of families, and provided 40 referrals to community resources.

In the month of April, Weatherization had 4 completions and 2 corrective works. Weatherization Specialist, Josh VanSkyhawk, traveled to Missouri to obtain his recertification for Quality Control Inspector and Evaluator. The team attended their quarterly IWAC meeting in Des Moines. The Clayton County Energy Workforce Summit was held. Outreach Director, Martin Ahrndt, and Weatherization Director, Scott Fisher, attended and were able to share the great accomplishments of LiHEAP and Weatherization!
