



What is Thrive Iowa?

Thrive Iowa is a community-led initiative based on the collective impact model to help families move from crisis to stability using resource navigation, community partners and a collaborative case management system.

Navigators

Navigators connect participants to existing community resources, advocate on their behalf, and ensure service coordination among providers.

HopeHub

HopeHub is a collaborative case management system that connects the organizations in your community to create a care team of cross-sector support.

✔ **Secure, Centralized Platform**

HopeHub is HIPAA, COPPA, and FERPA compliant for privacy and safety.

✔ **Real Time Data Sharing**

Providers collaborate instantly for coordinated care.

✔ **Transparent Outcomes & Progress**

Track participant progress and community impact with live dashboards.

✔ **Streamlined Communication**

All support team members stay informed and connected.

Point of Contact

Participants can be referred to HopeHub at any point. When participants are referred, a Navigator completes an intake assessment of 13 care areas. Scores in each care area help inform the participant's action plan addressing crisis areas first.

Connection

The participant assessment is updated monthly to track changes in progress across the 13 care areas. The Navigator makes referrals to providers and assembles the support team to address each area of need. New support team members are added, as needed.

Career

Employment is an important part of long-term stability. As participants build their stability, Navigators and Coordinators work with their Community Alliance and local employers to create opportunities for participants to obtain and advance in employment.

Eligibility

Iowa resident;
Parent/caretaker (custodial or non-custodial), of relative minor, pregnant;
US Citizen or legal resident;
Income 200% Federal Poverty Level or below
